



For years, the East Hampton Airport and aviation community have worked closely with elected officials, local community leaders, the FAA and local residents to keep the East Hampton Airport operating as it has been for over 75 years ó providing a vital transportation link, creating hundreds of jobs and helping to sustain the local economy.

Despite best efforts, an extremely vocal minority of residents has continued a **disingenuous and misguided campaign to close the airport permanently**. Despite the obvious negative impacts to the local communities, this possibility is looking more and more like a reality.

Now, after a number of local opposition members were voted onto the Town Board last fall they are poised to take action that will limit and potentially close the airport for good.

**To be clear, unless immediate action is taken flights into and out of the East Hampton Airport will be extremely limited starting in January and it is likely that the airport will be closed permanently in the near future.**

Luckily, there is still time to act but **we need your help**.
