As you know, over the past several weeks, East Hampton Airport and its supporters have fallen victim to slanderous attacks by the East Hampton Town Board.

Last month the Board financed a deeply flawed study that used outdated flight data to falsely accuse aircraft of not complying with route regulations. The study also failed to mention that many of the noise complaints filed in 2014 were solicited by an aggressive ad campaign.

In an effort to restore truth and balance to the story, we implemented an assertive rapid response campaign, criticizing the study and its blatantly misleading results.

Once the Town Board's tactics began to approach the point of outright lying and once again, we responded; publically exposing the baseless nature of the Board's comments and the true devastating impact that flight restrictions would have.
